

Air Temperature Note-taking Guide - Answer Key

Fahrenheit, liquid, vary, air temperature, scale, warmer, thermometer

Air temperature is simply a measure of how hot or cold the air is.

We use a <u>thermometer</u> to measure the air temperature of a place. A thermometer has a colored <u>liquid</u> in the hollow glass tube that shows what the temperature is. When the temperature gets <u>warmer</u>, the liquid shoots up!

The <u>scale</u> printed on the side of the thermometer measures the temperature in units called degree Celsius or degree <u>Fahrenheit</u>.

Temperature can <u>vary</u> from season to season and from place to place.
