## Expository Writing

This semester, your student has been learning about Earth Science. To extend this study, each child will be assigned a planet to research. The research and writing will be completed in class using a graphic organizer. On <u>Wednesday, April 4</u>, the graphic organizer will be sent home. You will complete the 5 paragraph essay at home. This is due on <u>Tuesday, April 10</u> along with your planet visual.

Your essay should be broken down into 5 paragraphs.

- Paragraph 1 introduction of planet; main idea of each body paragraph
- Paragraph 2 body facts about the planet; size, position in solar system, orbit, made of, gravity
- Paragraph 3 body facts about your planet; rings, moons, atmosphere, temperature, planet discovery
- Paragraph 4 **body** interesting facts about your planet; meaning of planet name, planet symbol, any other unique facts you discovered
- Paragraph 5 closing restate main idea

**Planet Visual:** You will create a 3D model of your planet. The planet must be on a stand <u>or</u> suspended from a box. It should be able to sit/stand on a flat surface. You will also write 5 facts about your planet to accompany the model. The planet visual is due <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>April 10</u>.
