We can use a pan balance or a <u>triple beam</u> balance to measure the <u>amount</u> of matter in an object.

The amount of matter in an object is called its mass.

Mass is a <u>physical</u> property of matter.

It is measured in kilograms. One kilogram is equal to 1000 grams.

Tess and Sean have made their guesses about the wooden block and nail.

Both of them have the <u>same</u> mass even though they look so different! The nail and the wooden block are made of the same amount of <u>matter</u>.
