tally table	a table that uses tally marks to record data
frequency	how often something occurs
frequency table	a table that uses numbers to record data
bar graph	a graph that uses bars to show data
horizontal bar graph	a bar graph in which the bars go from left to right
vertical bar graph	a bar graph in which the bars go from bottom up
horizontal	parallel to the ground and follows the horizon
vertical	perpendicular or at right angles to the ground
scale	the numbers placed at fixed distances on a graph to help label the graph
dot plot	a graph that records each piece of data on a number line

human capital	knowledge and work skills of people
income	money earned
labor	a work that a person does
salary	the amount of money a person can earn by being self-employed or by doing a job for another person or business
resources	something that is produced and used
purchase	to obtain by paying money for an item or a service
spend	to give money to someone else in exchange for something
lend	to give money to someone else that needs to be paid back
credit	to pay for something with money that is borrowed and must be paid back, usually with interest
borrow	when another person gives you money that you need to pay back

interest	s The money paid by a borrower to a lender for the use of the lender's money
savings plan	a plan that will help you save money regularly so you can reach your goals
